1.	<p>Female 76</p> <p>Right nasal mass incidental finding on CT for investigation of endocrine problem</p>	
2.	<p>Female 51</p> <p>Left maxillary sinus tumour extending into middle meatus and inferior meatus ? Inverted papilloma</p>	
3.	<p>Female 28</p> <p>9 week pregnant mass ulcerated mass right tonsil</p>	
4.	<p>Male 61</p> <p>Large neck lump</p>	
5.	<p>Male 48</p> <p>Soft, mobile subcutaneous lump on forehead of unknown duration.</p>

6.	<p>Male 45y Complained of left hemi-facial swelling and history of easily bleeding friable mass in the left ethmoid. The mass invaded the orbital wall.</p> <p>Dr WF Raslan</p>	
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
